

COSTS

- Membership Fee
 - \$50
 - Additional cost for donations to IBVCA

Tournament Entries

• \$25 each match

• Unique program costs

- Officials
 - Often covered by gate
- Travel / Transportation
 - If not covered by school bus, gas, liability insurance
- Player Insurance
 - If not covered by school
- Packs
 - Uniforms, facility, equipment, staff salary, etc.

• Offsetting costs

- Fundraisers
 - DiscoverIndy, trashbags, dessert catalogues, etc.
- Sponsorships
 - Local businesses, families, etc.
 - Pay attention to school district rules on these relationships

STARTING THE SEASON

First practices

Monday, February 28, 2022

First competition (must have 10 practices) Friday, March 11, 2022

Scrimmages are allowed before 3/11 but are not counted towards IBVCA matches / records.



SCHEDULING MATCHES

Home team provides officials, scorekeeper, libero tracker, scoreboard operator

Visiting team may provide a line judge if necessary

Recommended to rotate host location

COMPETITION RULES

- 4 matches per day
- 8 matches per week
- Varsity can only compete with Varsity
- JV / Freshman can mix (but JV teams cannot compete in Varsity tournaments)
- Varsity plays BEST OF 5 (deciding match to 15, win by 2, no exchange) except for tournaments, which are BEST OF 3
 - JV plays BEST OF 3, first to 25 (deciding match to 15, win by 2, no exchange)

TEAMS HAVE THE FREEDOM TO HIRE THEIR OWN OFFICIALS FOR ALL HOME MATCHES / EVENTS

VARSITY MUST HAVE IHSAA SANCTIONED OFFICIALS IN BOTH SPOTS; JV AND FRESHMAN ARE AS POSSIBLE (UP REQUIRED)

BEST OF 5 MATCHES PAY \$30 BEST OF 3 MATCHES PAY \$25

OFFICIALS

POST SEASON QUALIFICATIONS

- A coach or representative from each school must be a member of the IBVCA
- Each team must verify that they have competed in **8 matches** during the current season prior to the State Entry Deadline (May 8, 2022)
- A team must compete in **12 matches** to be eligible to host a Regional
- Teams can have **NO** out-of-district players

All athletes must be eligible under IHSAA sanctions and their school's code of conduct for athletic competition

RPI

Determines the state tournament seeding, taking into consideration *only* IBVCA matches

CALCULATION

RPI = (WP * 0.25) + (OWP * 0.50) + (OOWP * 0.25) WP → Winning Percentage OWP → Opponent's Winning Percentage OOWP → Opponent's Opponent's Winning Percentage

STATE TOURNAMENT AWARDS & RECOGNITION

State Champion & State Runner-Up Medals

All-Tournament Team & MVP Academic All-State

All-Star Selections

Each school gets one nomination (state finalists earn more)

Quarter-final losers coach teams





OUT-OF-DISTRICT PLAYERS

- Board must confirm out-of-district players prior to competition
 - Must be identified on team roster
- Athletes can remain out-of-district for 2 seasons
- Must apply in order of proximity to athlete's home school
- No school is <u>required</u> to accept an out-of-district athlete
 - May participate in All-Star Match
- Programs with out-of-district athletes on a varsity floor are barred from State Tournament



REPORTING SCORES

- Match **WINNER** must update scores on MaxPreps within 24 hours
- Tournament **HOSTS** must report *all* match scores to Board President

PRODUCES A WEEKLY RANKING OF THE **TOP 10 TEAMS**, AS VOTED BY THE MEMBERSHIP

IBVCA MEMBERS ARE ELIGIBLE TO SUBMIT THEIR RANKINGS BY **10 PM ET ON MONDAYS**

RANKED POLLS ARE PUBLISHED ON TUESDAYS AT NOON ET
